In this year's summit, Mr. Sabec will be speaking in the session "Web 4.0: It's Time for the Internet to Grow Up," in which he will advocate for a future when the IP of creators is protected on the web.

The 6th Annual 2015 Anti-Piracy & Content Protection Summit brings together experts in the film, TV, gaming, music, software, sports, and e-publishing industries, along with content producers and developers, law enforcement officials, government policymakers, and legal experts, to discuss and develop solutions to optimize content and copyright protection processes.
